


NEXT GEN BUILDING

CITY COMPASSION WAREHOUSE 320 W. HENSLEY BLVD

Our church's outreach ministry, City Compassion, stretches into the communities of Northeast Oklahoma to help the hurting and improve lives. Our efforts are prayerful, strategic, and always fueled by kindness. Our biggest limitation currently is warehouse space to store donations and food supplies.

We were gifted a 8,500 sq. ft. warehouse on Hensley Boulevard, which is located in the heart of the need! Construction has begun to prepare this facility for storing food, receiving trucks, and welcoming our neighbors. It will also include a large commercial walk-in refrigerator and freezer so we can store and distribute perishable items.
